

QCONF VOIP Service

QCONF enables anyone to dial into your conference through your internet connection (VoIP service).

Participants who use VoIP are able to forgo even the low local phone rates normally associated with using QCONF. This means no unnecessary charges on your phone bill, both for you and your conference calling colleagues.

What is VOIP?

VoIP stands for Voice over Internet Protocol. It refers to phone calls that are carried over IP networks, such as the Internet. (Read more about VoIP on Wikipedia.)

Many calling tools are available to make use of VoIP as a phone service, such as SIP phones, which provide many of the same calling features as traditional phones. Most VoIP tools must be installed on your computer prior to use.

What are the benefits of using VOIP?

Using VoIP lowers the cost of your phone service. In some cases, calling through VoIP may be free. Because we want to save our QCONF customers as much money as possible, we have enabled connection to our virtual conference rooms from any SIP phone.

How can I connect to QCONF through VoIP?

If you are able to dial a SIP address, simply call the following number:

This number will connect you to the virtual conference room, just as it would connect a landline or cell phone.
